- **Due to the shorter morning, there will be no AM Nursery- we will reopen AM Nursery on Monday 13 January.**
- 30 hour Nursery children may attend from 10.00am.

If this is the case, please do let us know as soon as you can by phoning the office or sending a message through MCAS. This will help us have an idea of the number of children to expect and plan effectively for lunches.**

Thank you once again for your support this week. Even tomorrow's arrangements are not ideal! We hope that a school day back with teachers and friends will go a little way to providing some return to routine and normality.
