

English

This half term our class novel is 'Secrets of the Sun King' by Emma Carroll. We will be reading this text to hook us into our theme of Ancient Egypt. In English lessons, we are writing a biography about Howard Carter (famous Egyptologist) and a fact file about Ancient Egypt/The River Nile.



We will be using a range of skills such as using homophones, prefixes and suffixes, adverbials of time, place and manner, brackets and dashes to indicate parenthesis and modal verbs to show certainty or possibility

We will ensure accuracy of spellings and punctuation by using dictionaries and our taught knowledge of spelling patterns and rules.

Science **Properties of Materials**

Hardness – the ability of a material to resist being dented
Solubility – how easily a material a material will dissolve
Magnetism – if a material is magnetic or not
Conduction of Heat – how easily heat passes through
Conduction of Electricity – how easily electricity passes through
Transparency - if a material allows light to pass through or not.

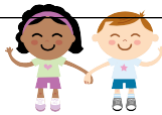
